

A Mathematical Phenomenon

Dr. Stephen West wrote the following "Reverse Pattern Number Chart" in the year 2000 after reflecting on the basic principals of Numberology and watching the numbers dance around forming reverse patterns. The numbers zero through four and five through nine reverse mirror each other. This is what happens when numbers zero through nine are multiplied and rendered to their smallest number:

Although Numberology doesn't include the number zero in their calculations, Stephen followed his imagination and inspiration led him to discover this pattern.

Basically, if you times each number by all other numbers beginning with zero and ending through nine, this is what you end up with after adding each number to their base number. So zero is always zero, and nine is always nine [$9 \times 9 = 81$ and $8 + 1 = 9$] with the exception of zero. The numbers between zero and nine reverse mirror each other perfectly! The numbers three and six aren't as surprising as the rest. Just take the time to visualize the patterns.

The relationships revealed by this chart are very interesting.

0 & 9, 1 & 8, 2 & 7, 3 & 6, and 4 & 5 - What do these numbers have in common?

Like the yin and the yang, they all demonstrate a simple opposition pattern in nature. Is it energetic? The significance of this pattern is yet to be found as this pattern is new so we don't know much about it other than it does suggest that a simple opposition or balance of the numbers. It takes only a few moments to discover for yourself.
